
INTAS - International Association for the promotion of co-operation with scientists from the New Independent States of the former Soviet Union

What is INTAS?



- **Ø** A not-for-profit International Association (AISBL) for the **promotion** of **scientific** cooperation between researchers in the NIS & its member states;
- Ø Established in 1993 jointly by the European Community and (at that time 12) EU Member States;
- **Ø**Joint by like-minded countries;
- ØHelps preserve the scientific potential in the NIS through *international cooperation*.

INTAS TOOLS and POLICY (1)



- Ø Supports *multilateral partnerships* between research institutes, universities & industry in the NIS and the INTAS member states;
- Ø Funds fundamental or applied research in *all* areas of exact, natural and human sciences;
- Ø Offers *grants* aimed at enabling scientists to engage in international scientific cooperation, with particular *focus on young scientists*.

INTAS TOOLS and POLICY (2)



- ØSubmission of project proposals and individual grant applications in the frame of calls;
- **Selection** by peer review on the basis of scientific merits, management merits, mutual benefit & socio-economic relevance;
- ØScientific policy and peer review system are overseen by a *Council of Scientists*.



INTAS TOOLS and POLICY (4)



INTAS developed:

Ø Tailor-made, targeted programmes & instruments suited to country-specific needs in post-Soviet science;

ØFlexible *co-funding arrangements,* involving partners both from INTAS member countries and NIS partner countries.

INTAS TOOLS and POLICY (5)



In addition to *Project grants* and *Young* Scientist Fellowship grants, INTAS has been:

- Ø Organising Scientific Policy Workshops both in Member States and Partner Countries;
- Ø Offering support to **Summer Schools** & other training activities;
- Ø Awarding Conference Grants to support the organization of scientific events and/or the individual participation of NIS scientists;
- Ø Supporting small-scale *Infrastructure Actions*;
- Ø Supporting a NIS-wide *E-library*

INTAS CALLS 1992 - 2005



Over 1992-2005 INTAS launched 75 Calls:

- **∨10** Open Calls for project proposals (~ 167M€);
- **∨11 Thematic/Regional Calls for project proposals (~ 16M€)**;
- **∨21 Collaborative Calls for project proposals (~ 27M€)**;
- **∨14 Young Scientist Fellowship calls (~ 16M€), from 1998 to 2005 (incl. 6 collaborative calls in 2005)**;
- **∨**3 Innovation Grant Calls (~ 1 M€), in 2003/04/05;
- **∨16 Other Support Actions (infrastructure, conferences, summer schools, e-library).**

IMPACT of INTAS (1992 – 2004)



253 million Euro provided funding for:

- ø ~ 2,800 research projects & networks;
 - ð support to ~ 15,800 teams of scientists;
- ø ~ 45 innovation grants
- ø > 1,200 young scientists fellowships;

And:

- ø 281 conferences & workshops;
- ø 66 summer schools;
- Ø 33 infrastructure actions.

INTAS FUNDING in the FP6 (2002-2006)



INTAS total budget in the FP6 will attain ~ 80 M€.

Ø ~70 M Euro from the European Community through the Framework Programme (INternational COoperation Budget)

- Ø~8 M Euro from co-sponsors in jointly funded activities
- Ø~2 M Euro from some member states of INTAS (Switzerland, France, Belgium)



- 156 environment projects





INTAS Thematic Call



Earth Sciences and Environment

- Ø Co-operation with ESA GMES Programme (Free of charge access to ESA images)
- Ø Indicative budget: € 0,9 million from INTAS
- **Ø** Main topics:
- Water management;
- Global Climate Change focusing on Carbon Stocks.
- Ø Funding / project up to € 120,000 (<25% INTAS MS).

- ∨ More than 12 years of experience in supporting EU-Russia/NIS scientific collaboration;
- ∨ Autonomy and simple management structure;
- ✓ Integrated management of the different activities (projects, fellowships, other support actions);

- **∨** Flexible co-funding arrangements;
- ∨ In general: Flexibility, Versatility & Responsiveness.
